## FOR LARGER BATCHES:

### MEGABEE PATTY MIXING GUIDE

- Patties are best made using a type of heavy syrup (HFCS, heavy sucrose syrup, or 50/50 blend). Heavy syrup can also be made using 2:1 sugar to water.
- For firm patties (ready to feed right away) follow the instructions and if desired add 4% oil for more moisture. Corn, coconut, or canola are best.
- For a softer patty, increase the amount of syrup to 1.25 lbs. per 1 lb. of MegaBee.
- If the patties appear thin, allow them to sit overnight as the MegaBee powder is intended to absorb and maintain moisture.
- Position the patties as near to the brood cluster as possible. Many beekeepers place the patties between the brood chambers to optimize availability for feeding the brood.

## FOR PATTIES:

NO MIXING NEEDED! JUST OPEN AND FEED

FOR BEST RESULTS PLACE CLOSE TO THE BROOD
