No Cook Recipe for Hansen Honey Farm Candy Boards

Materials:

10-Frame Hansen Honey Farm Candy Board

18 pounds granulated sugar

18 ounces water

Optional – two teaspoons Honey B Healthy, Hive Alive, or other feeding supplement. Large pot or tub for mixing

Directions:

1. Mix the sugar, water and feeding supplement by hand in a large bowl. Make sure it is thoroughly mixed.

2. Place the Hansen Honey Farm candy board frame on a piece of wax paper, cardboard, or metal tray with the hardware mesh side down.

3. Fill the candy board with the sugar mix, pressing firmly into place through the hardware mesh on the bottom until the frame is full. (When the frame is full, you can use a rolling pin or piece of PVC pipe to further press the mix into the board.)

Carefully move the board where it can dry (be careful to support the bottom so the sugar mix does not fall through!). It will take about two days for the mix to fully dry. After day one you can place shims under the board to allow for air circulation.

When fully dried it is ready to place on the hive under your inner cover.
